

Barcelona to Ibiza & Balearic Islands by Motor Yacht

May 9th – May 19th 2023 (weekly schedule)

Join us as we head from Boston MA to Barcelona Spain and then cruise on a 73 Foot Motor Yacht “Explorer” to beautiful Ibiza and the Balearic Islands off the Coast of Spain in the Mediterranean.



April/May is Marathon season in Ibiza and known for active, healthy outdoor enthusiasts who enjoy an active mature lifestyle, 5K's, 10K's, 26.2's, etc and still like to live up the evenings with all night dancing. Ibiza is “the” place to be for the Summer and all the Spaniards in the know crowd the Island in July/August but the spring months are much more relaxed, low key and quiet from the party/club/DJ scene. Spring temps in usually in the 60s-70s. Accommodations aboard are upscale w/full kitchen, 4 cabins, bathroom/hot showers etc but cozy so best for small groups or large families who know each-other. Perfect for Bachelors/Bachelorette parties, Milestone Birthdays, Destination Weddings, Corporate Retreats, Sporting Groups, Family Gatherings, etc.



In Barcelona, we stay the first 1 or 2 nights and the last 1 or 2 nights at Diagonal Zero SB Hotel (hoteldiagonalzero.com) which has a Day Spa & Wellness Center included, near Port Forum Marina, close to tapas bars, tourist attractions, biking, hiking, boating, jet-skiing, wine tasting, and culinary adventures. This allows for varying flight schedules and a fixed boat schedule. Flights are frequent and direct non-stop from Boston.

Detailed Itinerary: Barcelona to Ibiza & Balearic Islands by Motor Yacht

Day 1: Flight BOS to BCN

Always direct, non-stop, we book all flights
Most flights are 10pm EST depart, which means
12pm noon, next day arrival, with the 6 hour
time change.

Day 2: A Jet Lag Catchup Day, Relax at Spa &
Wellness Center
Self-Directed Exploring Tourism Day of
Barcelona and/or Group Tapas Dinner Night.



Day 3: Walk to the Marina at Port Forum
(about 5 minutes from Hotel) and
Board the Motor Yacht, introductions to the Crew.
Settle in for a Relaxing Travel Day to Ibiza with
amazing views of Barcelona before the overnight.



Day 4: Awake in Ibiza! Step off of the “ALMA Explorer” for an Exploration Day – Suggestion: Tourism of Ibiza’s cultural heritage during the Day, then Dinner, Dancing and Nightlife in evening. All Crew members are English speaking and know the area well, most multi-lingual and are well-paid during your week. Your Crew will assist with ideas, excursions, activities, health & safety, security, etc. Luggage and portage assumed up to 2 pcs per person. Ibiza is a very affluent area, however, all usual tourist precautions exist. Hotel taxes, crew tips, and service fees are included. The crew does usually sleep in separate crew quarters on front of boat away from main cabin area.



A Chef prepared Spanish Breakfast and a Light Lunch, Every Day on the Boat. Fully Stocked Kitchen is available for Snacks, Coffee, Water, Beer, Wine, Beverages, etc

Day 5: Flex Day – Suggested Beaches, Sports, Jogging, Biking, SUP, Cultural Activities, Kayak, Tourism, Hiking, Nightlife, Dinner, etc.

Day 6: Flex Day – Suggested Yoga Retreats, Jogging, Biking, SUP, Kayak, Tourism, Hiking, Nightlife, Dinner, etc.

Day 7: Flex Day – Suggested Shopping, Sports, Jogging, Biking, SUP, Kayak, Tourism, Hiking, Nightlife, Dinner, etc.

Day 8: Flex Day – then a Chef prepared Group Sunset Dinner prepare for the return trip in overnight/early morning.

Day 9: Arrive in morning by Yacht back to Barcelona from Ibiza – and walk to same hotel in or go direct to airport depending on flight schedules. Those staying have time to tour Barcelona again, art museums suggested. Self-directed dinner or group tapas and wine tasting evening in downtown Barcelona. Most fly next day.

Day 10: Return flight to BOS from BCN. Motorcoach from BOS to Seacoast NH. All flights are always direct, van transfers from Hotel/Marina to airport are included, however, most flights are evening hours, so guests are encouraged to self-tour the city and self-UBER or Taxi to airport a few hours before return flight. Don't forget the 6 hours you will recapture!
